**Research Experience**

Currently, I am investigating *Antrodia camphorata* grown on germinated brown rice inhibits human hepatic HepG2 cells proliferation via G0/G1 cell cycle arrest and apoptosis induction. *Antrodia camphorata* grown on germinated brown rice (AGBR); AGBR-hexane, AGBR-BuOH and AGBR-EtoAc extracts. I studied cell culture, Cell proliferation assay, DAPI staining, Flow cytometric cell cycle analysis and Western blotting analysis and I also studied metastasis effect of *antrodia camphorata* (in vitro and in vivo). I studied G2/M Phase Arrest by *Cordyceps militaris* Grown on Germinated Soybean, through Down-regulation of Cdc25c and Cyclin B1 in Human Colon Cancer HT-29 Cells. Extract preparation from various kinds of sample like as mushroom.

I studied age-dependent fertility lose of ob/ob mouse. The leptin-deficient ob/ob mouse is characterized by a morbid obesity and infertility. Histology (H & E staining) of ovary, vaginal smear and Reverse transcription polymerase chain reaction (RT-PCR) analysis were carried out. Hematoxylin/eosin-stained count the CL and ovarian follicles. Real time-PCR, TUNEL staining analysis, RIA method to measure blood-hormonal blood level, etc., were routinely carried out.

I studied anti-cancer effect of a medicinal plant (*Bulnesia sarmienti*) on human lung cancer (H460 and A549) and colon cancer (SW480 and HT29) cell lines in vitro and in vivo. MTT assay, DAPI staining, colony forming assay, RT-PCR, cell cycle analysis, DNA fragmentation, annexin V-FITC staining, and immunoblot analysis on cells were extensively utilized. I also studied Anti-Metabolic Syndrome Effects of Wild Ginseng in 3T3-L1 Adipocyte and ob/ob mice. During that study I adopted established scientific methods such as western blot, cell cycle analysis, cytotoxicity assay, blood glucose analysis, histological staining, etc.

Established the radioresistant cell line H460R from radiosensitive parental H460 cells. To identify the radioresistance-related genes, we performed microarray analysis and selected several candidate genes. During that study I adopted established scientific methods such as clonogenic and MTT assay, microarray analysis, western blot, RT-PCR etc.
